2006 Langtry Estate Cabernet Sauvignon *Tephra Ridge Vineyard*

The wine has a deep dense garnet color, while the nose is bursting with spices and dried fig; the scents of cedar, musk, nutmeg and sweet tobacco embellish the fruit aromas almost like a perfume. This Langtry Cabernet is full-bodied and structured; the tannins envelope the mouth as they dissolve and reveal the long dark fruit flavors on the pallet.
